Leading your team

- Role of the Region Manager with a new District Manager or Asst District Manager :
- Induction (also Region Team member)
- Appointment of Learning Partner
- Signoff of some Passport activities
- Appointment of qualified DM /Asst DM
- PS: There is no need for induction of CURRENTLY appointed Manager





- There is a qualification in the ALQP for District Managers and Assistant District Managers
- All details are in the District Management Passport, and Guidance notes
- There are six modules
- 6 months timeframe for a Manager with previous Guide Leader/Manager experience

Context



- For a Manager with previous Guide Leader/Manager experience there is no need to complete the module "Being involved with Guide Units"
- Induction of the new Manager is critical to a good start

Induction - Who?



- Region Manager inducts DM. Asst DM and Region team members
- RM is inducted by State Commissioner
- Asst RM is inducted by State Commissioner or her assistant

Purpose of induction

- GIRL GUIDES
- Understand your responsibilities as a Girl Guide Manager
- Have basis information about the District you will be working with
- Be clear about the process of qualification
- Meet State GG organisation requirements, including complying with relevant legislation

- Roles and responsibilities of DM
