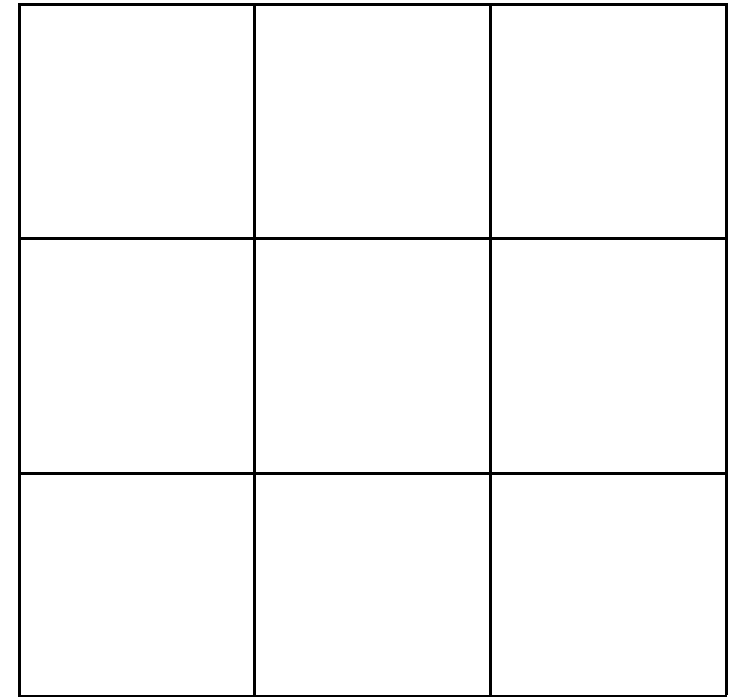
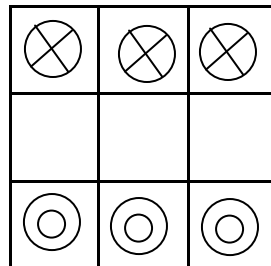


Seega
