The Dark Horse Venture (DHV) is an award scheme for financial Trefoil Guild members aged 50 years and over.

Participants join the scheme by taking up an activity of their own choice, something they have not seriously tried before. They set themselves targets or goals within their subject and must continue to undertake their venture for at least 12 months.

HOW THE SCHEME WORKS:

- · Register.
- Decide on activity and set targets.
- Send in your activity notification form to The Australian Trefoil Guild Dark Horse Venture Coordinator.
- Challenge yourself!



There are five categories in which people can participate and may include any activity which people think will fit into one of the categories:



GIVING & SHARING ACTIVE & CREATIVE PEOPLES & NATIONS TOMORROW'S WORLD HISTORY & HERITAGE

Giving and Sharing: could include volunteering, fund raising and community activities.

Active and Creative: looks at sport, fitness, performing/visual arts, crafts, creative writing, creating or joining study or interest groups.

Peoples and Nations: topics such as crosscultural projects, developing links and relations with overseas organizations, music, dance, drama, cuisine, world history, religious studies, languages, travel.

Tomorrow's World: looks forward with activities which create future benefits, environmental and conservation issue activities with children and young adult mentoring.

History and Heritage: includes oral history, lifelong learning programs, family ancestry, historical studies and research, archaeological projects, and local history.





The membership fee to join Australian Trefoil Guild Dark Horse Venture program is \$30.00. An annual administration fee of \$5.00, due on 1 February, is payable to the DHV Coordinator. This covers postage, stationery and communication expenses incurred by the Coordinator. Once the membership fee is paid, a DHV kit - which includes Personal Journal, membership badge and other literature relevant to the DHV program is sent to the member via snail mail or email. The ATG coordinates the DHV program on a self supporting basis. Any unforseen expenses that occur will need to be covered by the participant.
