Call for Nominations for AP Region Committee

Nominations will open shortly for members of the AP Regional Committee.

GGA is seeking interest from members who may wish to be put forward for a position on the committee.

The Regional Committee is responsible for:

- Developing and implementing Regional Action Plans that support the delivery of WAGGGS's Global Strategy (as approved by Mos at World conference) at a regional level.
- Implementing decisions made at the Regional Conferences
- Providing input based on their regional perspective to the World Board to inform its decision making

Commitment:

- The Regional Committee meets quarterly via conference calls with the option of short monthly meetings if required. It is expected that the role will involve a minimum of 15-20 hours per month.
- Regional Committee members are expected to work effectively in a diverse, multicultural setting, demonstrating cultural sensitivity and awareness in all interactions and decision-making processes to ensure inclusive and respectful engagement with all members of the regional team.
- The members of the Regional Committee are elected to serve a term of 3 years. They are then eligible to stand for re-election for a further term of 3 years, if they wish to, if they have met the role's expectations and if endorsed by their Member Organisation.
- The role will commence from the time of the Regional Conference in August 2025.
- Committee members may hold portfolios in the areas of relationships with MOs, volunteer management, capacity building, communications, finance, or a region-specific role.

Process and Timeframe:

- There is a maximum of 6 members on the Committee. During the 2025 Regional Conference, MOs will elect 6 individuals to form the Committee for the 2025 – 2028 triennium.
- Submit your interest/application to GGA by 20 November.
- Nominations to WAGGGS - opening 13 Dec and closing 13 Feb 2025
- Webinars for potential candidates will be held on

30 Nov from 14.00 UTC – 15.30 UTC

14 Dec from 11 UTC – 12.30UTC

This will clarify questions regarding the terms of reference, the role, work and tasks of a committee member – and the nomination process.
