



Adult Action Badge 2026

The Adult Action badge challenges Adults in Guiding to be involved in a variety of activities; expanding networks learning new skills and having fun at a range of Guide events in the same way the Youth Action badge does. To earn the Adult Action Badge, you must complete the syllabus within one calendar year. The 2026 Adult Action Badge is blue.

You must complete all the 4 required challenges plus 6 from the optional activities list by **end of 2026** to receive your badge. Challenges cannot be cross-credited. Each challenge must be its own event or activity.

Required Challenges (complete all 4)

- Volunteer to be on a committee or staff at a Region or State event
- Teach a skill to one new Leader or group of Leaders
- Complete a Service project with your Unit, Peer Group, District, Region, Trefoil Guild or other Guiding group
- Your choice, let your imagination run wild! Venture out into the community, in uniform, with your Guiding Group (Unit, Peer, Trefoil Guild etc). We'd love you to share a photo!

Optional Challenges (complete at least 6)

- Celebrate 30 years of the Olave Program by participating in an Olave event or connecting with Olaves in your District/Region
- Visit another Unit, organise and run an activity during the visit
- Participate in a State event
- Participate in a Region event
- Participate in an international event

- Try something new with other adult members (Olaves, Leaders, Trefoil Guild members or other volunteers)
- Volunteer for a new role or join a District, Region or State Team
- Recommend another adult for an Adult Award
- Recommend another adult for a new role or position (challenge is complete when the role is accepted)
- Go on an overnight sleepover/weekend camp/hike with your Unit, another Unit, your Peer group, or an adult hiking group.
- Take your Unit or Peer Group to a new place to learn a new skill
- Gain a new qualification
- Attend a Leader Event (e.g. Conference, Training, Workshop etc.)
- Attend a PR event
- Learn about a WAGGGS program (i.e. Surf Smart, Free Being Me, Girl-Powered Nutrition) and then participate in some of the program activities with a group that you are working with (i.e. Unit, District, Guild, committee).
