Register your <u>Unit's Community Clean Up</u> and:


- You get an event page with all your Clean Up details

- Help Clean Up Australia collect important data that feeds scientific progress, policy decisions and important funding.
- Please register your Clean Up, even if you don't need any materials.






THE CLEAN UP DAY!

Once you register your event, Clean Up Australia will send you a Clean Up kit with everything you need for a successful day!

- If you don't receive your kit in time for your event, you can make a kit at home using:
 - Durable gloves (gardening /washing-up gloves work well)
 - Garbage bags or other bags
 - Tongs or garbage pickers or grabbers
- If you didn't request printed resources to be included in your kit, you can <u>download the digital files.</u>







THE RUN ORDER



If you are the Event Supervisor, your Clean Up might follow these steps:

- 1 Unpack your Clean Up Kit and get materials ready at your meeting location.
- **2** Welcome your volunteers as they arrive.
- Brief your volunteers on how the Clean Up will work and safety measures. These <u>Clean Up Speaking Notes</u> can help you know what to cover.
- 4 Agree on a time to return to the meeting point.
- 5 Count the contents of one rubbish bag (more info on following pages)
- 6 High fives all round you're done!
- 7 Dispose of collected rubbish.







END OF CLEAN UP REPORT

WHY DO WE COUNT THE LITTER?

Litter data from Clean Ups helps Clean Up Australia gather national statistics on waste.

This information is vital for identifying litter trends across the country, shaping solutions, and supporting government advocacy and funding efforts.

Doing a Quick Litter Count of a sample of the litter you collect contributes to this important work.

THE QUICK LITTER COUNT

It's easy to do a Quick Litter Count and only takes a few minutes.

- 1 Select one of the co-mingled bags of rubbish you have collected (or one rubbish and one recycling).
- **2** Empty the rubbish onto a spare bag, tarp, or the ground.
- Complete the online <u>End of Clean Up Report</u> OR fill out the paper form in your Clean Up Kit and send it to us via email or post (instructions are on the form).
- Do a quick count of the Priority Items and submit (or do a comprehesive count if you have time!)

DISPOSING OF RUBBISH

You can dispose of rubbish

- in home, business, or public bins
- or contact your local council to arrange a collection if there's a lot of rubbish.
