## Share the Dignity Its in the Bag Campaign

Olaves are calling all girl guide units across Australia to participate in Share the Dignity's 'It's in the Bag Campaign' in 2025. Girl Guides Australia's participation in this campaign in 2024 was immensely successful. We hope to eclipse last year's contribution of 724 bags and meet a goal of donating 800 bags.

This campaign is an annual appeal for donations of bags filled with essential sanitary items to donate to people in need. Donations are distributed to over 3,000 charities nationwide to spread a little bit of love, dignity and comfort over the holiday season.

Whilst Olave Program members are encouraged to spearhead this campaign in their local Guiding communities, all members and Units are encouraged to participate and contribute where local Olave Program members are unavailable to do so.
